Grade X & XII Result :

As the curtains fall on yet another academic year, we take immense pride in celebrating the **remarkable achievements** of our Grade X and Grade XII students.

In the Grade 12 board examination, Rahul J and Adarsh Mishra S topped the list with scores of 485/500, while Sowbarnika Veni Vasanthkrishnan and Dhinesh N followed closely with 482/500. Akshatha K secured the third position with 478/500.

Exhibiting commendable mastery, Grade 12 students secured **six perfect scores in AI, one in BST, and two in Physical Education** in the board examinations.

Grade 10 students delivered an excellent performance, with Samyugthaa K. K. taking the **first rank** by scoring **481/500**. The **second rank** was jointly achieved by Divya K and Vasundhara A. with **479/500**, followed by Rithvik S and Akshatha A. securing the **third rank** with **478/500**. In the board examinations, Grade 10 recorded a **centum in Mathematics**, highlighting remarkable achievement.

Celebrating Academic Excellence:

The school proudly celebrated exceptional academic excellence by awarding prestigious scholarships for Grade X achievers, applicable toward their Grade XI and XII education. This year, Samyuktha K K secured the first rank and was awarded a 100% fee concession.
